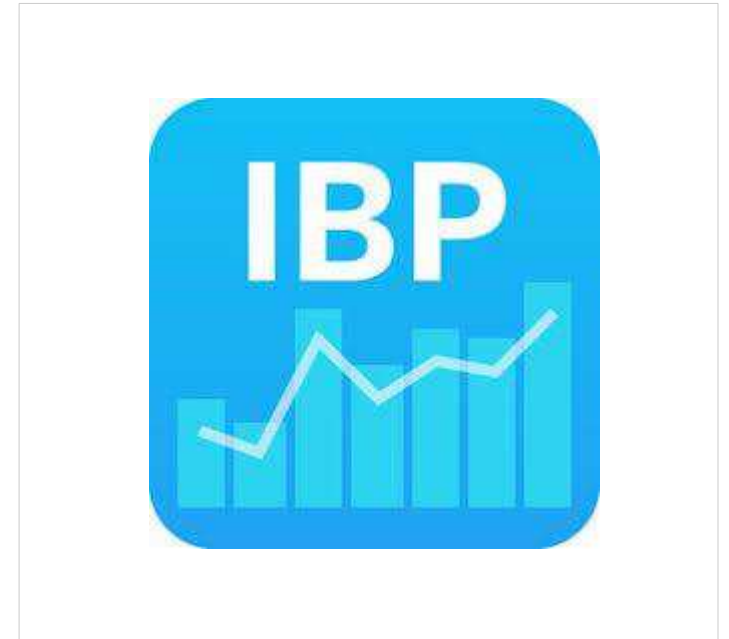

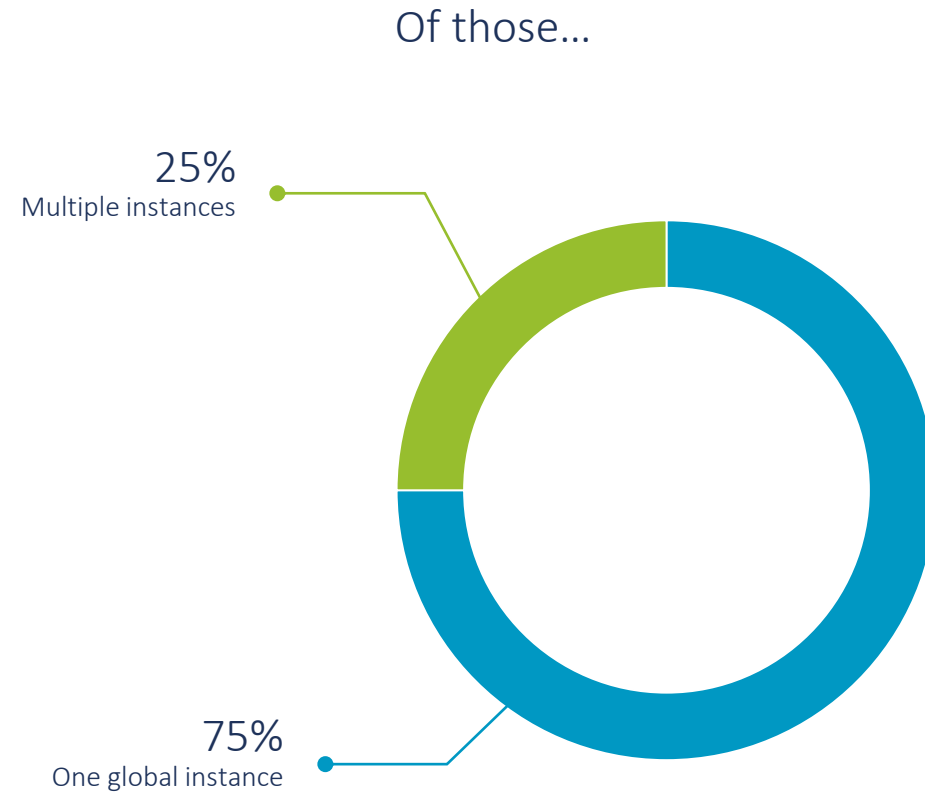

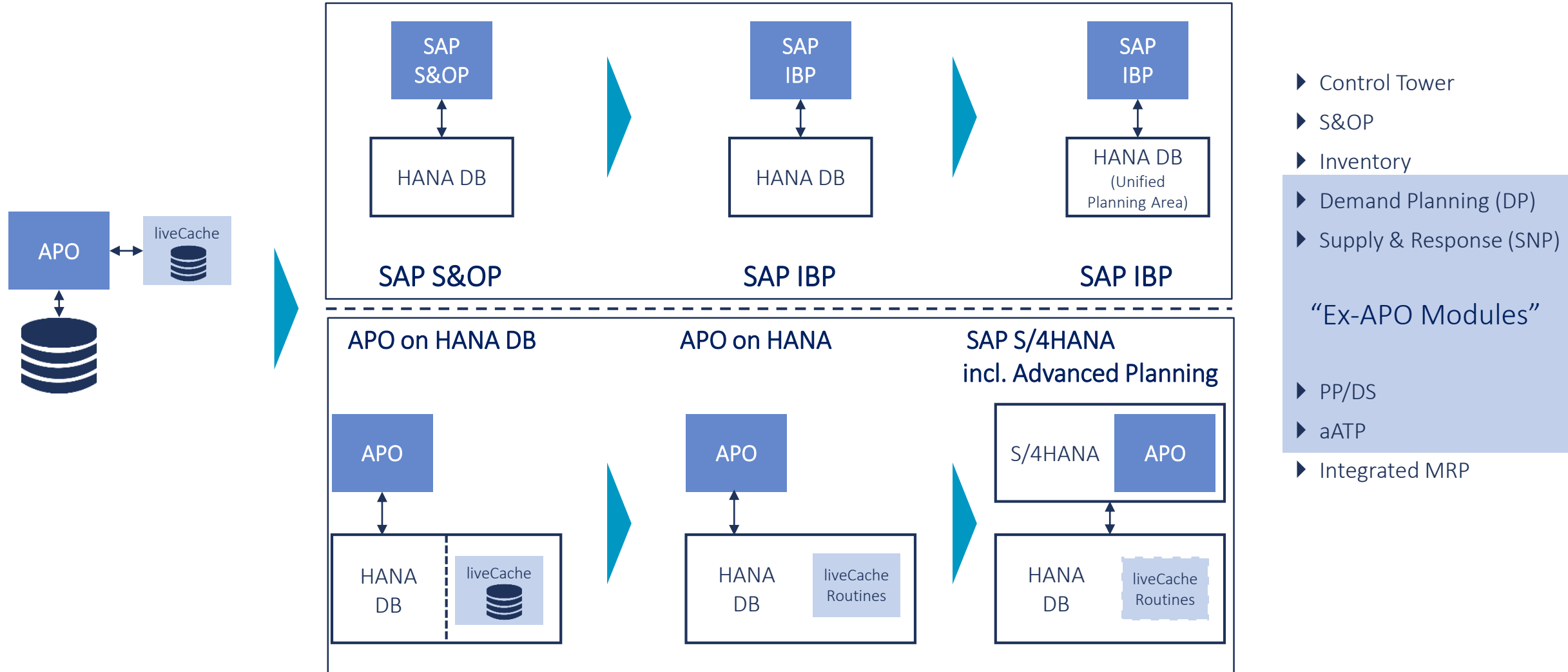

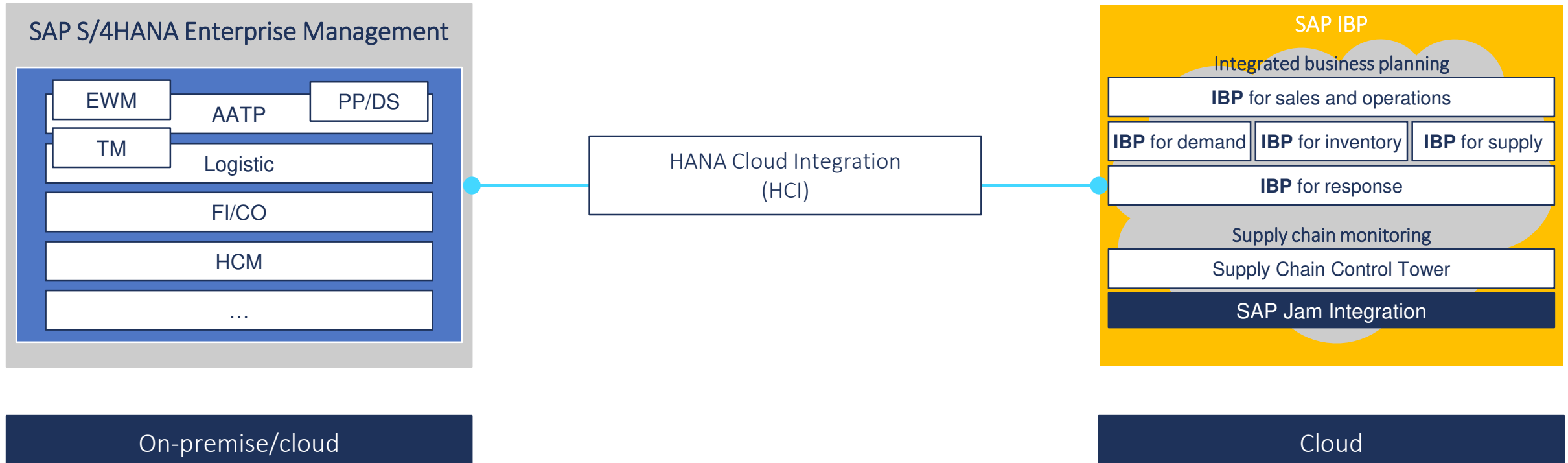

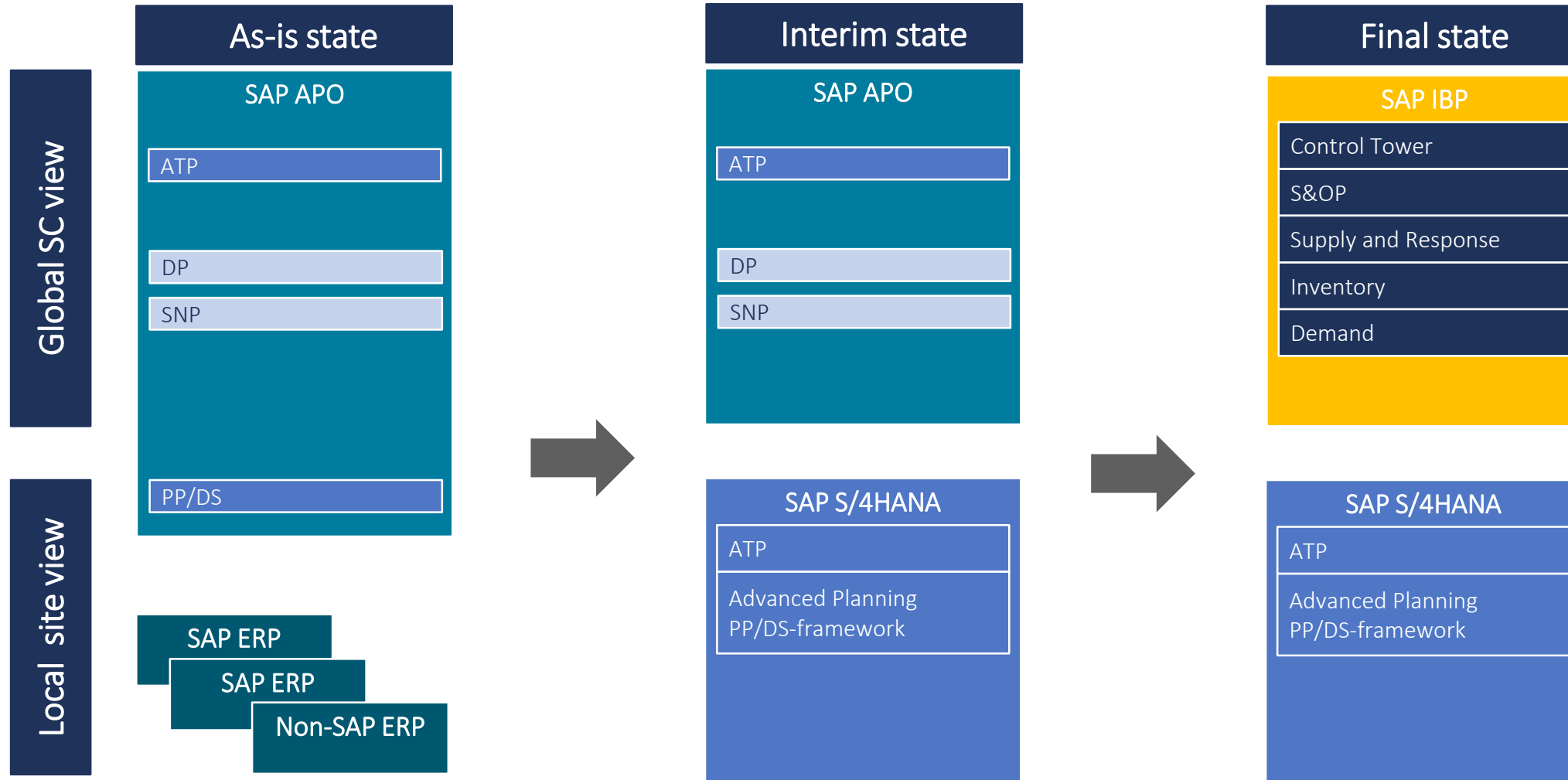

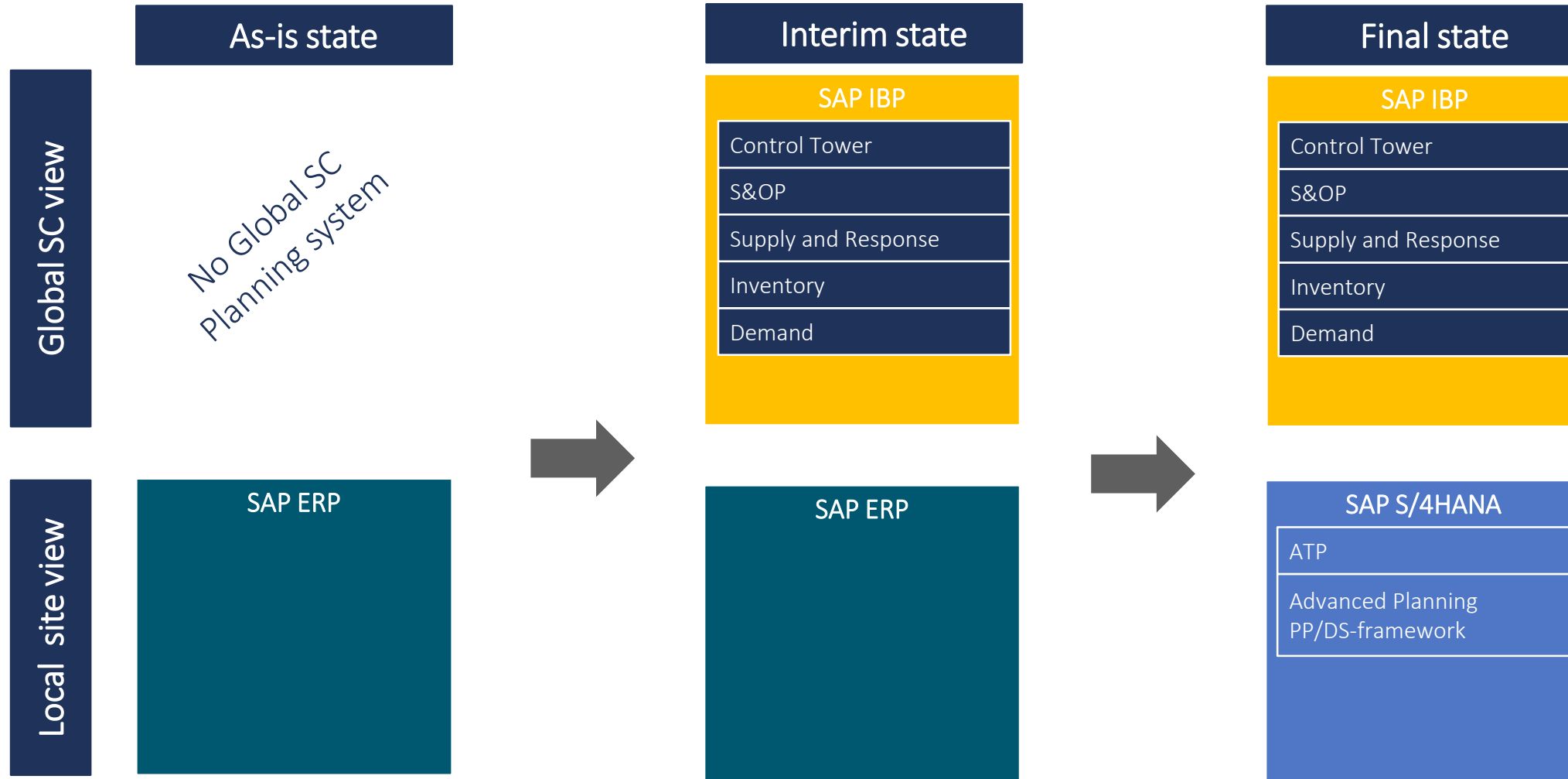

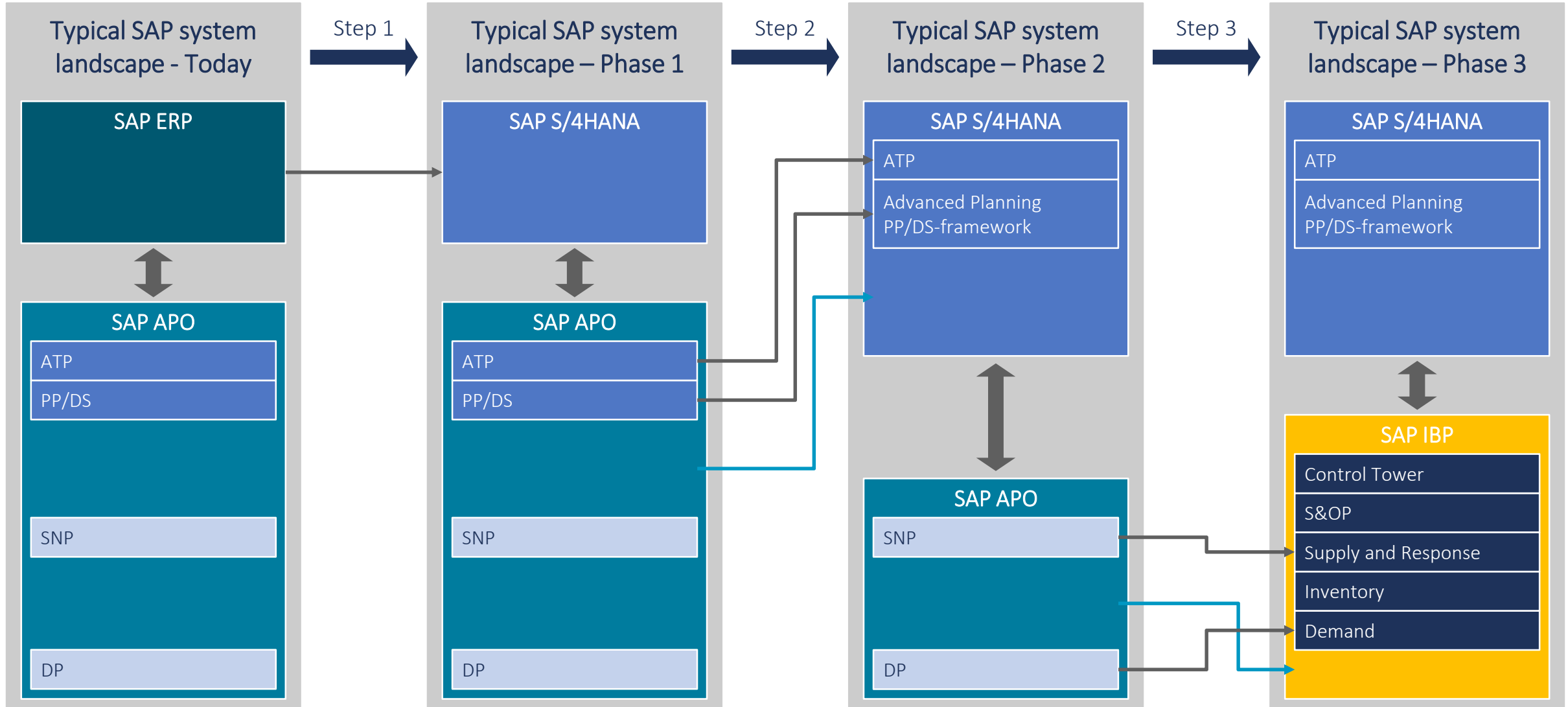
Scenario 1: first ERP consolidation in S/4HANA then Global Planning in SAP IBP



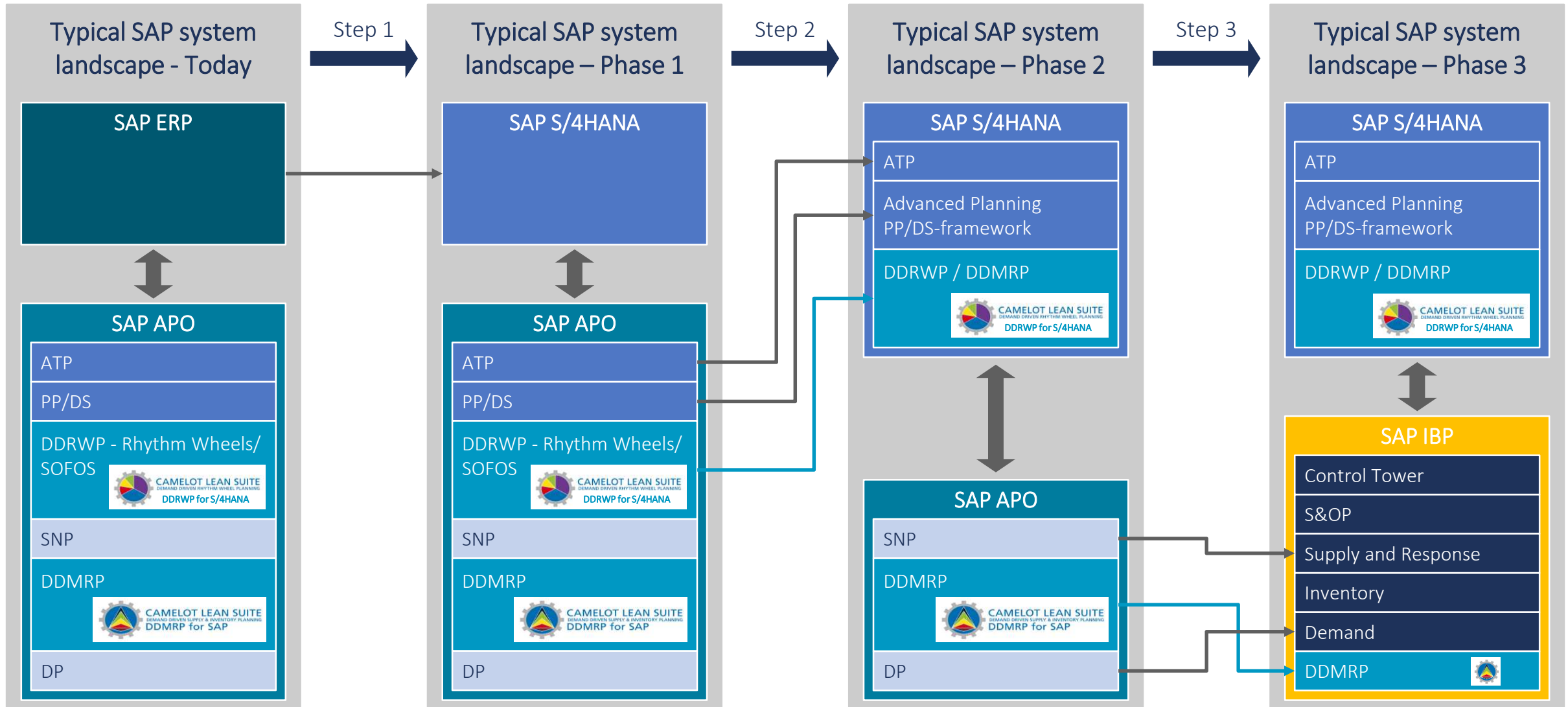
Scenario 2: first Global Planning in SAP IBP then migration to SAP S/4HANA
